Great News for my dental family!

The Frederick Dental Team along with all medical and dental offices has finally been allowed by the Maryland Department of Health to open for elective procedures. We will be opening on Wednesday, May 20th. We will open at a reduced scale to optimize the opportunity to provide a safe environment for your dental treatment.

My utmost priority always has been, and remains to be, the health and well-being of our patients. To minimize the potential for cross-contamination between patients and staff, we will be adhering to several new procedures. I'd like to ask for your cooperation in enacting these new policies.

Once you have an appointment scheduled, you will receive an email and or text with a wellness form to complete prior to your appointment. Please, fill out the Wellness form and return back to the office. Doing so will minimize time spent inside the office itself, and, crucially, will eradicate the need for us to share pens or hand off materials. For those that forget to fill out the forms, we will have paper forms at the reception desk, but again, please try to avoid this option.

There will be some new accounting procedures that are necessary to maintain your safety. An enhanced Infection control fee of \$20 will be required for each dental visit.

When you arrive at the office, you may call or text our office you have arrived if you prefer to

wait in your car. We will call or text you when it is your turn. We are following social distancing parameters. Our waiting room will have limited seating so we ask only the patient enter unless patient needs assistance or is a minor.

Please enter our office wearing a facial covering, and use the hand sanitizer available. As healthcare providers, we are mandated to take your temperature with a forehead thermometer and ask several Covid-19 related questions. We truly appreciate your patience as we adhere to these new inconveniences.

These new measures will stay in place for the indefinite future, and are an unfortunate manifestation of this new reality we all share. My goal is to continue providing quality dental care in an environment that is as safe as possible. Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we navigate these troubling times.
